Weekly Word

O Lord our Lord throughout the earth, how glorious is your name!

As I recall these words from psalm 8, in preparation for Trinity Sunday, I give thanks for all creation. Fin and feather, fur and scale, stars, fog, sun, moon, and this earth, 'our island home.'

It is a blessing at this time to be traveling for the work of the councils of the church, meeting with the Episcopal Church of the United States, and understanding a little bit more of the worship and service, practice and mission of our Anglican Neighbours to the south.

I remember and recall how we at the Ascension are linked to this wider church, through our diocese, the national church, and the worldwide Anglican Communion.

I think of the work of the early apostles shortly after Pentecost, of their concern for the spread of the gospel and the sustaining of the fledgling community in various parts of the Roman Empire. Even though there were vast differences in geography, culture, language, and custom, the person of Jesus, and the gift of baptism were unifying factors that propelled the church to care and to serve; to work toward the building of God's Realm.

There were differences and misunderstandings then between apostles and communities, as there are at times now.

There were different emphases in the mission of the church, to Gentiles, and to the Jewish community. We have different emphases now.

There was a call for an offering to the church in Jerusalem - to the wider church beyond individual communities, as there is now.

I pray during this season after Pentecost, in my experiences, studies, thoughts, and prayers, I may be open to God.
